It's been rewarding to see projects grow, such as the children's holiday scheme which has gone from strength to strength and is now highlyvalued by many local families, or the Hanwell Community Centre Consortium which has now its own independent identity and existence and is working to secure the future of the historic Hanwell Community Centre as a community asset. HBL has also supported the local traders on Greenford Avenue in setting up the North Hanwell Traders Association, offered a wide range of training opportunities to local people, supported the local youth clubs, enabled the training of two gardening apprentices and gardening sessions at Copley Wood and given small grants to local groups and individuals. All these activities bring benefits to our area and it continues to be satisfying to be part of enabling these positive changes to happen.

Hanwell Big Local is in its 4th year. It is a 10-year community project covering the Cuckoo, Gurnell, High Lane and Copley estates and surrounding roads. It's led by local residents who have volunteered to work on the project but it belongs to ALL the residents in these areas.

Hanwell Big Local is funded by the Big Lottery Fund and managed by Local Trust. Big Local is an exciting opportunity for residents in 150 areas around England to use at least £1m each to make a massive and lasting positive difference to their communities.

I am so grateful to HBL for funding my CELTA course. I had wanted to gain this qualification for a long, long time, but it was way out of my budget. I applied for the HBL Fund and was over the moon when I received the email to say my application had been successful.

The course took place for a full day once a week over 20 weeks and was incredibly challenging! I was thrown into the deep end of having to plan lessons and stand up in front of a class of 16 learners to deliver what I had prepared, whilst being scrupulously observed by the tutors and fellow colleagues! Then there was the methodology! It really made my head hurt. I rose to the challenge and passed with flying colours!

I am now delivering lessons in my local community centre free of charge to residents which they say they are enjoying so far! Applying for this fund from the HBL is definitely a win/win situation - because many people in the community reap the benefits as a result!

Small Grants

Horticulture Project Green Hanwell

The Green Hanwell Project has made great progress this year! A team of 40 volunteers from CIF came to the project to build composting units at Paddington Court, plant wildflowers and build a beetle pyramid at Copley Woodland and build bird boxes.

During the summer, several groups of local children attending the HBL / EASE Summer program visited Copley Woodland and Paddington Court to help out with the project. The woodland was explored, raised beds were painted and masses of bird boxes were decorated which are now proudly situated in the trees in the woodland. Many of the same children returned to the woodland in October half term to build dens!



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The youth club at Gurnell Grove spent Halloween planting up vegetables by torch light to provide the community centre with some delicious edibles for winter.

The apprentices, Alex and Francis, continue to keep the flowerbeds at Gurnell Grove blossoming and looking wonderful. We are looking forward to doing some fruit tree and bulb planting over the next coming months.



At the beginning of the year traders agreed objectives for the year and continued to encourage all traders to participate in the development of the group.

Traders developed a logo and created a website which will enable them to host information on businesses, discounts and update the community on events and plans. The group has been identifying priorities for the parade and has begun to liaise with local authorities including Councillors and police. In November following negotiations with Councillors and Ealing recycling team a major clean up of the private land behind the parade took place.

Through Hanwell Big local funding the team



has delivered two events a Summer Beach Party and a Christmas Fair. All events are done in collaboration with local residents, charities and schools. Residents helped with the logistics of the event and local schools have taken stalls and sent their choirs to entertain. Traders have purchased some small equipment to facilitate future events and also t shirts and hoodies with logos.

The team has negotiated with the support and funding of local Councillors a 5 year plan for Christmas lights on Greenford Avenue.

The team continue to apply and source funding to assist with the ongoing development of the group and in order to deliver future events.

Hanwell Big Local and EASE have been providing holiday schemes, which have been running from Hanwell Community Centre. These have been very popular, always fully booked and well attended.

Children aged between 5-12 years old have participated in a range of activities such as Arts & Crafts, Cooking, Football , Sewing, Basketball, Canvas painting, Jewellery making, Bird box painting ,T-shirt painting, Lantern making, Pumpkins carving, trips to Northala Hills, Woodlands, Bunny park, Go Ape and Oxygen.

Youth Group Mentoring

Hanwell Big Local have again funded EASE to continue with our group mentoring sessions with our trained mentors this year at our Youth Clubs. Young People will benefit from sessions looking at self-esteem; confidence building and giving tools for other important life skills that will set them up for their individual journeys.

Teen Activity Sessions/ Youth Trips

HBL funded Youth Go-Karting trip in Summer Holidays. Young people loved it and they were very grateful for the opportunity as many of them never have been to Go-karting before.



We are excited to be able to provide motivational speaking sessions for our teenagers to first understand and identify the rising issues of youth gang/violence in their community, and to provide tools and strategies address the issues that all our young people face.
